Trinity International Schools Financial Aid Application

Criteria for Qualification:

1. Student must be enrolled as returning student in grades K—12 at Trinity International Schools—or—
2. New student applicants may submit a Financial Aid Application after notification that the student has been accepted for enrollment.
3. Student must meet all enrollment eligibility requirements.
4. Required documentation along with the completed application is to be submitted to the school office in a sealed confidential envelope address to Trinity Educational Foundation:
 - Student to submit a one-page summary as to why they want to attend Trinity International Schools including how they would contribute to the school (Exempt for K-2 students);
 - Parent or Guardian to submit a one-page summary as to why they want their child to attend Trinity International Schools and why financial assistance is needed;
 - Parent or Guardian to submit a copy of most recent year's signed and dated tax filing form to verify income received;
 - Parent or Guardian to submit a current credit report.
5. Financial aid is granted for one school year or one semester, as applicable. Student must maintain a 3.0 grade point average
6. Parent or Guardian is expected to participate in school parent activities and will agree to assist with the Foundation's annual fundraising events.
7. Financial aid may be suspended when a student has received five office referrals for any infraction of the Student Code of Ethics or for poor attendance or loss of credit due to attendance and tardy violations. If financial aid is suspended, Parent or Guardian are responsible for the amount of assistance withdrawn. Decision to suspend financial assistance is made by the Foundation Executive Directors.

Explanation of Application Process:

- Upon receipt of application, it will be reviewed for completeness by the school fiscal staff and prepared for the next Trinity Educational Foundation meeting.
- Incomplete application packages will not be processed and will be returned.
- Applicant will receive a notification letter from the Foundation.
- If an award is granted, applicant will receive an adjusted statement of your financial contract with the school which will indicate how payments due have been adjusted (i.e. reductions in FACTS withdrawals).
